Tournament Sanction Agreement

It is the MTA's desire to provide MTA member clubs with the programs and resources needed to ensure that their events are of the highest quality and run as professionally as possible. One of the many goals of the Montana Taekwondo Association (MTA) is to help coordinate a Taekwondo "season" for Montana Taekwondo athletes to (1) foster a sense of community among Montana martial artists; (2) provide opportunities for athlete, coach, and referee development state-wide; and (3) establish and maintain the highest possible standards for Taekwondo competitions held in Montana.

Montana Taekwondo Association Sanction Benefits

1. MTA-sanctioned events benefit from the enhanced support of MTA member clubs.
2. MTA-sanctioned events benefit from the advice/guidance/assistance of the MTA's leadership (if desired) to help ensure its success.
3. MTA-sanctioned events may rent the MTA's scoring equipment and mats (rental fee applies).
4. MTA-sanctioned events may use the MTA's web site, mailing list, logos, collateral, and other materials and resources to promote and run the event.
5. MTA-sanctioned events contribute to the selection of the MTA's Cadet, Junior, and Senior Teams (athletes can only earn points for team selection by competing at MTA-sanctioned events).

Requirements for Sanctioning Your Event with the MTA

Please initial the following* to indicate that you understand and will comply with the listed requirements:

- _____ The host must be an MTA member in good standing and the host club must be an MTA member school in good standing.
- _____ The host must agree to abide by MTA rules and guidelines for Taekwondo competition.
- _____ The host must be able to reasonably ensure enough personnel (volunteers) to run the event.
- _____ The host must provide at minimum six (6) MTA-certified referees in good standing (enough to run a ring) for the event.
- _____ The host must guarantee that adequate medical personnel (EMT or better) will be working the event.
- _____ The host must acquire liability insurance for the event and specify the MTA and MTA officials as co-insured.
- _____ The host is responsible for transportation of rented scoring equipment and mats to the event.
- _____ The host must provide a statistician for the event and submit a tournament report and results within seven (7) days following the event.
- _____ The host must provide MTA members with a \$10.00 discount off the entry fee for the event.

* All requirements must be initialed for the MTA to sanction your event.
